ACR Methodology for the Quantification, Monitoring, Reporting and Verification of Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions Reductions from the Destruction of Ozone Depleting Substances (ODS) and High-Global Warming Potential (GWP) Foam

V.1.1 → V.1.2

The following is a summary of significant changes made in version 1.2 of the ACR *Methodology for the Quantification, Monitoring, Reporting and Verification of Greenhouse Gas (GHG)* Emissions Reductions from the Destruction of Ozone Depleting Substances (ODS) and High-Global Warming Potential (GWP) Foam relative to version 1.1. Version 1.1 was published in September 2017. Version 1.2 was published in November 2021.

As of January 2020, production, import and consumption of new or virgin HCFC-22 is fully banned in the U.S. per the EPA¹. V.1.2 of this methodology removes the below restrictions on eligible sources of HCFC-22 for destruction.

Eligibility	Removes the requirement, found in section 2.2.1, that HCFC-22 refrigerant must be recovered from operating equipment that is decommissioned or retired. Removes the requirement, found in section 2.2.1, that HCFC-22 refrigerant sourced from stockpiles is ineligible.	2.2.1
